Dr. Rosenberg began a career in sleep as an undergraduate in the laboratory of Arnie Leiman at the University of California, Berkeley. He worked for Allan Rechtschaffen in the Sleep Research Laboratory at the University of Chicago and received a PhD in 1980 and did a postdoctoral fellowship at Argonne National Laboratory working with George Sacher. In 1986 he started the Evanston Hospital Sleep Disorders Center and was a member of the Departments of Neurology and Psychology of Northwestern University. Dr. Rosenberg served on the AASM Board of Directors from 1994-2000 and the AASM Board of Directors from 1999-2003 before joining the AASM staff as Senior Director of Science and Research and subsequently became Director of Professional Education and Training and Education Coordinator for the AAST. Dr. Rosenberg is now the Chief Executive Officer of Rosenberg Sleep Consulting, with clients including the AASM and AAST and teaches research methods in the Department of Psychology, California State University, Long Beach.

Kathleen Bennett, DDS, Diplomate, ABDSM

Dr. Bennett is a 1979 graduate of Georgetown University and a 1983 graduate of University at Buffalo School of Dental Medicine. She completed her GPR at Buffalo General Hospital in 1984 and practiced restorative dentistry for 19 years. She became an ABDSM Diplomate in 2002 and served on the education committee for many years.
