GENERAL REGISTRATION

The registration fee includes admission to the AADSM 20th Anniversary Meeting general sessions on June 10-12, industry supported events, and the exhibit hall. The required fees for attending ticketed events - educational courses (June 10) and meet the professor sessions (June 10-12) - are listed on the registration form. You must register for the AADSM 20th Anniversary Meeting general session to register for any ticketed events. Registrations will not be processed unless accompanied by payment in full.

Membership types are as follows:

Member: To register as a member, the registrant must currently be an individual member of the American Academy of Dental Sleep Medicine (AADSM). If the AADSM is unable to confirm that the individual is a member of the society, the AADSM will register the individual as a nonmember for all sessions at the prevailing fees.

Student/Graduate Postdoctoral Student Member: To register as a student member, the registrant must currently be a student member of the American Academy of Dental Sleep Medicine (AADSM). If the AADSM is unable to confirm that the individual is a student member of the society, the AADSM will register the individual as a nonmember for all sessions at the prevailing fees.

Dental Staff of AADSM Member: To register as the dental staff of an AADSM member, the registrant must currently be employed by an individual member of the American Academy of Dental Sleep Medicine (AADSM). If the AADSM is unable to confirm that the employer dentist is a member of the society, the AADSM will register the individuals as a dental staff of a nonmember for all sessions at the prevailing fees.

The AADSM does not offer registration to only attend educational courses or meet the professor sessions. These sessions have limited seating and are sold on a first-come, first-served basis. Advanced purchase of tickets is strongly encouraged. The AADSM does not have a waiting list for sold out sessions. Topics and speakers for the sessions are available in this program. The price of the meet the professor sessions covers the cost of your meal only.

MEMBERSHIP DISCLAIMER

To register as a member, the registrant must currently be an individual member of the American Academy of Dental Sleep Medicine (AADSM). If the AADSM is unable to confirm that the individual is a member of the society listed above, the AADSM will register the individual as a nonmember for all sessions at the prevailing nonmember fees. If you wish to become a member and take advantage of the membership benefits, you must submit your membership application at the time of submission of your AADSM registration form. CANCELLATION

In order to attend meet the professor sessions, you must be registered for the general session. The AADSM does not offer registration to only attend meet the professor sessions. These sessions have limited seating and are sold on a first-come, first-served basis. Advanced purchase of tickets is strongly encouraged. If the meet the professor session is full, you will not be charged or will receive a refund. Lunch is provided at this session. Meals are pre-selected with standard dietary needs in mind and cannot be substituted to accommodate special needs.

CONFIRMATION

After registering for the AADSM 20th Anniversary Meeting, registrants will receive confirmation from the AADSM via e-mail. It is recommended that you bring your confirmation notice with you to the meeting.
